## Rules 2018

1. All rules not stated below specifically will go by the T and C newest rulebook

## 9-12 Baseball

1. 3 inning max pitching for any pitcher per game
2. Time Limit: 1 hour 45 minutes or 6 innings whichever comes first
3. 6 runs per inning allowed with NO continuance except for last inning is unlimited runs
4. Once a ball is pitched in an inning that counts as an inning
5. Required facemasks for all hitters
6. Start of $9^{\text {th }}$ inning will implement California rules: last batter out will start on $2^{\text {nd }}$ base
7. Make up games should first utilize Saturday at 10 am and Noon before other days
8. Tournament
a. 12 innings total pitched by one pitcher during entire tournament.
b. No time limit, 6 innings played unless extra innings needed

## Minor Softball

1. No pitching limits but pitchers cannot start consecutive games
2. Time Limit: 1 hour 45 minutes or 6 innings whichever comes first
3. 11 inch ball being used
4. 6 runs per inning allowed with NO continuance except for last inning is unlimited runs
5. Once a ball is pitched in an inning that counts as an inning
6. Required facemasks for all hitters and fielders playing $1^{\text {st }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ or pitcher
7. New T and C rule is drop third strike is out of rules. Dropped ball on third strike still an out
8. Tournament
a. No pitching limits
b. No time limit, 6 innings played unless extra innings needed

## Machine Pitch Baseball

1. 5 pitches
2. 6 runs per inning allowed with NO continuance except for last inning is unlimited runs
3. Required facemasks for all hitters
4. $1: 15$ time limit
5. The box is considered the catchers box as well as the batters box
a. Once ball leaves any of those boxes after a pitch the runners may advance
b. A ball on the line is considered to be IN the box
6. Tournament
a. No time limit, 6 innings played unless extra innings needed
